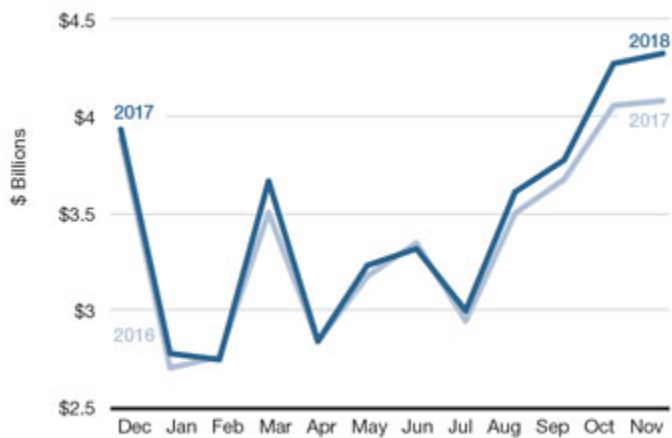

U.S. Wine Sales Value Up 6% in November

U.S. wine sales rose 6% in November to \$4.3 billion, market research firm bw166 reported. Domestic table wine sales drove growth, rising nearly 6% to \$4 billion while sparkling wine sales rose just 2%. Value growth exceeded volume. Bulk wine sales were flat as wineries pared demand following a large domestic harvest. Domestic wine sales increased 4% in the latest 12 months, boosting total wine sales in the U.S. 5% to \$71 billion.

U.S. wine sales totaled \$4.3 billion in November, up 6% from a year ago. This was the strongest growth of the year.
